Content

Through our accounts we aim to keep New Brunswickers informed about the electoral process in the province and specific activities of our office during election events. We repost news releases, information about voter registration and voting opportunities and other relevant information about the events that we administer.

Messages

We actively monitor our social media accounts and aim to respond in a timely fashion to questions and messages which may require a response.

As a non-partisan agency of the legislative assembly, we don't respond to questions or posts that fall outside of our mandate or that take a position on political issues or matters of public policy.

Any comments that we view as inappropriate, partisan or abusive will be removed.
