Declaration of Chief Financial Officer

The following declaration must be signed by the chief financial officer accepting his or her appointment [84.3(3)(h)]:

1. I accept my appointment as chief financial officer of this third party.
2. I am aware of the duties and responsibilities of this position as provided by subsection 84.35(4) the *Political Process Financing Act*. A chief financial officer shall be responsible for the following matters:
 - a) ensuring that the third party complies with the provisions of the *Political Process Financing Act*;
 - b) accepting election advertising contributions made to the third party;
 - c) authorizing all election advertising expenses incurred by or on behalf of the third party;
 - d) maintaining the books, records and other documents of the third party; and
 - e) filing the reports of the third party required under section 84.6.
3. I am aware of the qualifications to be a chief financial officer provided under subsection 84.35(2) the *Political Process Financing Act*. I declare that I am not:
 - a) a candidate;
 - b) an official agent of a candidate;
 - c) a chief agent of a registered political party;
 - d) an electoral district agent of a registered political party;
 - e) an official representative or a deputy official representative of a registered political party or a registered district association;
 - f) a member of the executive of a registered political party or a registered district association; or
 - g) an election officer.
