Local government by-elections will be held on Monday, May 6, 2024, for the following positions:

Arcadia (M14)	one councillor, ward 3	Île-de-Lamèque (M05)	one councillor, ward 3 one councillor, ward 5
Campobello Island (M13)	one councillor, ward 2	Lakeland Ridges (M16)	mayor two councillors, ward 4
District of Carleton North (M17)	one councillor, ward 4	Nackawic-Millville (M15)	one councillor, ward 5
Grand Lake (M15)	one councillor, ward 2	Tracy (M14)	one councillor-at-large

Nominations for these positions can be submitted to the Municipal Returning Officer starting **Tuesday, April 2, 2024**. Nomination papers must be submitted **before 2 p.m. on Friday, April 12, 2024**. Nomination papers are available at your local returning office, or they can be printed from our website: www.electionsnb.ca.

Polls will be held on **Monday, May 6, 2024, between 10 a.m. and 8 p.m.** for any local government offices if more candidates are nominated than can be elected. **Advance polls** will be held **between 10 a.m. and 8 p.m. on Saturday, April 27, 2024**. Electors should receive individual Voter Information Cards in the mail starting on **April 22, 2024**, setting out all polling locations for their polling division.

INFORMATION FOR ELECTORS

Getting on the Voters List: A person’s name must be on the voters list in order to vote. If you are on the list, you should receive a Voter Information card in the mail starting on April 22, 2024. If you have not received a Voter Information card, your name may not be on the list (or not under your current address). You can have your name added to the list by completing an application for addition until May 2, 2024, or when you go to vote. If you have moved recently, but have voted before, your name may be on the list at your former address. Call 1 888 858 VOTE (8683) to have your voter information updated.

Who Can Vote? You can vote if you will be at least 18 years old on Election Day, are a Canadian citizen, and have lived in the province for at least 40 days immediately before the date of the by-election and will be ordinarily resident in the municipality and ward where you wish to vote on the date of the by-election.

ID for New Voters: To be added to the voters list, you will need one or more pieces of identification which between them show your name, current address, and signature (but not financial or credit cards). A person without sufficient ID may be vouched for by a voter at the polling station whose name is on the voters list for that polling station.
