Ordinary polls will be held on **Monday, April 14, 2025, between 10 a.m. and 8 p.m.**

Advance polls will be held on **Saturday, April 5, 2025, between 10 a.m. and 8 p.m.** at various locations.

SPECIAL BALLOTS

House-bound or hospitalized voters unable to attend either the advance or regular polls may have a special ballot brought to them by staff of the municipal returning office, or any voter may vote by special ballot at the municipal returning office starting on March 31. The returning office also has an audio-vote system that allows visually impaired electors or anyone with reading difficulties to vote independently. Voters temporarily out of the province for work, study or travel can have a special ballot sent to them by the returning office. Call the number at the end of this notice, or the returning office, as soon as possible for more information on these voting options.

POLLING STATIONS

You should soon receive a Voter Information card in the mail, showing your polling division number and where the ordinary and advance polls are for that polling division. Bring your card for faster voting service at the polls. If you do not receive a card, call the Municipal Returning Officer at the phone number below, or check our Web site for your poll number and polling stations.

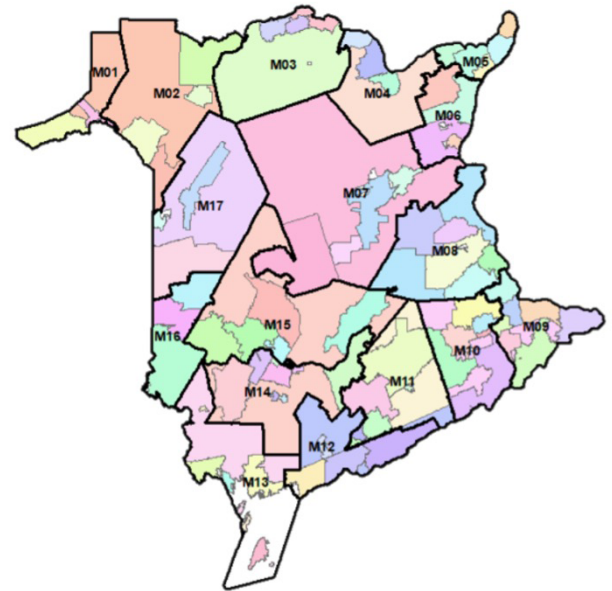

GETTING ON THE LIST OF ELECTORS

A person's name must be on the list of electors in order to vote. If you are on the list, you should receive a Voter Information card in the mail starting on March 31. If you have not received a Voter Information card, your name may not be on the list (or not under your current address). You can have your name added to the list by completing an application for addition until April 10, or at the regular or advance polls when you go to vote. If you have moved recently, but have voted before, your name may be on the list at your former address. Call 1 888 858 VOTE (8683) to have your voter information updated.

If you will be 18 years old by April 14, 2025, are a Canadian citizen, and have lived in the province for at least 40 days immediately before the date of the election, and will be ordinarily resident in the local government, and ward where you wish to vote on polling day, you are qualified to vote.

To be added to the list of electors you will need one or more pieces of identification which between them show your name, current address, and signature (but not financial or credit cards). A person without sufficient ID may be vouched for at the polls by another voter who is on the list for the same polling station.
