CLAIMS FOR ELECTION EXPENSES CONTESTED BY OFFICIAL AGENT

Every person to whom an amount is due for election expenses shall present his claim to the official agent later more than 45 days following polling day. Otherwise, such person shall forfeit the right to recover the claim [*Political Process Financing Act*, s. 76(1)].

Where an official agent contests or fails to pay any claim for election expenses allegedly incurred by the official agent or by a person authorized by him or her, the claim shall be deemed to be a contested claim. The claimant may bring an action in any court of competent jurisdiction to recover the claim [s. 91(1)]. Claims for election expenses contested by the

official agent shall be reported below [s. 81(1)].

The particulars of any subsequent payment, including a payment in consequence of a judgment of any court, on any claim for election expenses allegedly incurred by an official agent or a person authorized by him or her and previously listed as contested shall be disclosed forthwith to the Supervisor of Political Financing [s. 84]. Such communication would occur subsequent to filing this Return.
