






# A Ratings Guide For Your Food Premises

<h2>How serious are the violations on your inspection report?</h2>	<h2>Definition</h2>	<h2>What this means for you...</h2>
<p>Violations noted during inspections have been ranked according to their severity or likelihood to cause illness.</p> <p><b>Minor</b> – violation is not likely to cause an immediate risk to human health.</p>	 <p><b>GREEN:</b> High standard of compliance with no more than 5 minor violations.</p>	<p>Your food premises generally meets the requirements of the regulation.</p>
<p><b>Major</b> – violation indicates there is a breakdown in hygienic practices OR violation may represent a risk to human health.</p>	 <p><b>LIGHT YELLOW:</b> General compliance with 6 to 9 minor violations.</p>	<p>Your food premises does not meet the requirements of the regulation. Although there are violations, there is no indication of an immediate health risk to your customers.</p>
<p><b>Critical</b> – violation indicates there is a direct risk to human health.</p>	 <p><b>DARK YELLOW:</b> General compliance with no more than 3 major violations.</p>	<p>Your food premises does not meet the requirements of the regulation. The violations noted indicate there is a breakdown in hygienic practices and/or there may be a health risk to your customers.</p>
<p>The overall ranking of your premises is calculated according to the number of violations noted in your premises (see table).</p>	 <p><b>STRIPED RED:</b> Premises remains open with one or more critical violations and/or 4 or more major violations and/or 10 or more minor violations.</p>	<p>Your food premises does not meet the requirements of the regulation. The violations noted indicate there may be a health risk to your customers. Prompt attention is required.</p>
	 <p><b>RED:</b> Licence has been revoked for non-compliance.</p>	<p>Your food premises fails to meet the requirements of the regulation. Your premises is closed until all conditions set by Department of Health have been met.</p>
