



ONLINE HARVEST REGISTRATION FOR DEER, BEAR AND MOOSE

New Brunswick has had mandatory registration of harvested big-game animals (deer, bear and moose) for several decades. The harvest registration process provides important biological information required for sustainable management of these species. In addition, harvest registration provides mechanisms to assist law enforcement personnel with monitoring of legal possession and trade of these valuable public resources.

Starting in the fall of 2021, the Department of Natural Resources and Energy Development is introducing a remote, online, self-registration process as an option for hunters to report the harvest of big-game animals. In-person registration of animals at DNRED District Offices and at private registration stations will remain in place, but hunters will have the option to use internet-based technology to self-register their harvest when in-person registration stations are closed, or not located conveniently on the hunter's route of travel.
